WHAT'S NEW

July 29, 11:15 AM – “Neringa Tour” – a welcome tour for all parents, especially of the new campers. Neringa Alumni will lead the “Neringa Tour” and will answer any questions you have.



IMPORTANT: In recent years there are more and more children with **severe food allergies**. We ask you not to bring food or candy to camp as that places campers with allergies at risk. Food/candy also attracts rodents. The kitchen staff prepares rich, healthy and delicious meals every day.



ARRIVAL-DEPARTURE Sunday, July 29 is arrival day and registration is 10 am (not earlier!) – 12 pm.

Camp ends after the flag raising ceremony at 10:00 am on Saturday, Aug. 11. We encourage those camping for only one week to camp during the first week. Departure after the first week: Sunday, Aug. 5, 1-3pm. We do not recommend visiting your children after the first week; this seriously impacts the program and the morale of other campers. “Third Week” Youth Camp for 12-16 year old campers starts Saturday, Aug. 11 at 4 pm and ends after the flag raising ceremony at 10:00 am on Saturday, Aug. 18.

Please note: Neringa is unable to transport children to camp from the airport. If you are unable to find transportation you may call the Camp Director for suggestions.

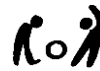
PACKAGES NERINGA does not allow any care packages. Any packages sent will be held back and returned upon departure.

YES, DO BRING: All of your special talents and anything you need to share them, e.g. musical instruments and sports equipment. Also, letter writing paper, envelopes with stamps, pens and pencils, as well as any other items that would enhance program participation.

Ø **DO NOT BRING:** Electronic equipment (MP3 players, cell phones, iPods, video games, etc.), posters, comics, candy, gum, snacks. Leaving behind city sights and sounds helps one to appreciate the natural surroundings of Neringa and allows everyone to be fully involved in the camp program. Any items brought to camp will be taken into the summer manager's care until departure (for more information, refer to letter *About Electronics*).

DIRECTIONS TO NERINGA: I-91 to Vermont exit 2. Follow Rt. 9 west for 7 miles until you see the sign for Neringa. Turn left onto MacArthur road and in less than a mile you will see the Neringa driveway on your right.

REGISTRATION POLICY: Send the completed registration form **and health form(s)** with the down payment (checks made payable to **Camp Neringa, Inc.**) by APRIL 1, 2018 to: CAMP NERINGA, c/o 4 JOHNSON STREET, NEWBURYPORT, MA 01950. **The balance is due by mail June 29. Payments are not accepted opening day.**

CONDITIONS: The down payment (less \$30.00 registration fee) is refundable only if a cancellation is made two weeks prior to the beginning of camp. Camping fees are not refundable less than one month prior to camp, nor once the camp session has begun (including instances of camper dismissal). Camping balances remain in effect for registration changes made less than one month prior to the start of camp (e.g. if a family with three registered children has not paid their tuition in full by the deadline and on the opening day of camp states that one child is dropping out, the family still owes the balance of tuition for all three children).

CANADIANS: Please mail your payments in US funds drawn on a US bank. If you note so on the registration form, you may submit your second payment in cash on site.

Financial assistance is available from Blessed George Matulaitis Fund, Kazickas Family Foundation and others.
